Guaranteed capacity

All Emirates AOG shipments are given priority treatment. Parts weighing 0-100kgs are accepted up to 4 hours prior to departure, whilst parts between 101-1000kgs are accepted up to 6 hours prior to departure. Our wide-bodied fleet has a cargo carry capacity of up to 14,000kgs. So whether it's big or small, we ensure its safe transportation on your preferred flight.

Priority service

Every Emirates AOG shipment is prioritised at each stage of the journey, starting with expedited ramp-side transit of less than 90 minutes. On arrival, Emirates AOG parts weighing between 0-100kgs are cleared in just 2.5 hours from arrival, whilst parts weighing 101-1000kgs are cleared in only 4 hours.

Our dedicated Emirates AOG team are available 24/7, 365 days a year. They monitor your shipment's movement through our digital track-and-trace platform, which provides both shipper and carrier with regular milestone updates.
